
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CHANNELADVISOR CONNECTOR USER GUIDE





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I. Features

It is our honor to introduce you our ChannelAdsisor Connector. The Connector provides real-time connectivity from Magento to ChannelAdsisor and quickly updates your Inventory to ChannelAdsisor via their API. Its main features are listed below:

A. Real-Time Inventory Updates

- The connector helps you update Inventory in real time from Magento into ChannelAdvisor on creation, edit and deletion (CRUD) for products, including mapping image data, stock management and control.
- > If you alter any information on your inventory items in the Magento admin panel, these changes will then be automatically synchronized with ChannelAdvisor.
- > Other changes will be synchronized if inconsistencies are found since ChannelAdvisor is contacted at a designated interval (15 minutes by default) to investigate ChannelAdvisor for modified product data. Modifications that are discovered then imported into Magento.
- Two-way connectivity is optional you can choose to synchronize changes both ways either from Magento to ChannelAdvisor and ChannelAdvisor to Magento or only one way from Magento to ChannelAdvisor or vice versa.
- The module provides an easy way to map your product inventory from Magento to ChannelAdvisor and vice versa by employing attribute mapping system inside the Magento admin panel and module configuration.
- Flexible according to your needs: This connector is highly configurable. As a store owner, you are able to update inventory from Magento to ChannelAdvisor and vice versa. Moreover, it lets you control exactly which attributes are mapped and not mapped. The module assists you to manage your stock level, and to decide whether to import the orders or not as well as to control fulfillment process.

In fact, all features of the module can be turned off or on and configurable according to your needs.

> We also now provide support in for multiple images per product as well as mapping configurable and grouped products via variations in ChannelAdvisor.

B. Real-time stock synchronization

- If any modifications are made in stock levels in your Magento store, they will be updated simultaneously in the corresponding stock levels in ChannelAdvisor.
- The last-known stock levels on both Magento and ChannelAdvisor are stored in the Modules database when you install the ChannelAdvisor Connector. That enables the comparison of stock on both systems so that if a decrease occurs on each system, the correct tally will be executed. In other words, the module ensures data integrity throughout both platforms. This process is activated at a user designated interval (15 minutes by default) to examine the differences and then updates Magento stock.

C. Order Management and Fulfillment

- > Import Sales Orders into Magento: Orders in ChannelAdvisor will be collected by Magento (the system polls ChannelAdvisor) at a designated interval (10 minutes by default) we set a default of 10 minutes since it is the required notification period for new orders generated on the marketplaces according to Ebay's recommendation.
- > Order Prefix for Easy Management: Orders are prefixed by a combination of ChannelAdvisor and Marketplaces. These prefixes can be defined by users and then the Connector will base on these prefixes to identify the orders and send fulfillment details (shipping carrier, type and shipping details) back to ChannelAdvisor when the order is marked as complete or another user designated order status.

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In addition, the file *massExport.php* in this module is aimed at preventing network errors when updating a mass of products. All products with their own setting characteristics in Magento are exported to ChannelAdvisor by executing these statements below:

CD /YOUR/PATH/TO/MAGENTO
CD CHANNELADVISORAPI
PHP MASSEXPORT.PHP

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II. How to use the ChannelAdvisor to Magento Connector

This section provides you with information on the basic configurations to run this module smoothly and appropriately. Some technical terms are also explained and detailed module settings are displayed in this section.

A. Changes after installing ChannelAdvisor Connector

After your installation, you will see two main changes in your Magento admin page. The first modification is a new admin menu labeled WiseRobot added on your Admin menu. The second appears on your configuration page.

The first change: New admin menu: WiseRobot

The WiseRobot menu occurs as a result of the installation.

On Admin menu, select WiseRobot → ChannelAdsisor API

From ChannelAdvisor API, there is a drop-down list comprising of settings such as *Account ID map*, *Attribute map*, *Classification*/ *Category map*, *Attribute set map*, *Shipping methods map*, *Payment methods map*, *Manage sales source for order import*, *Image placements*, *Mass update to ChannelAdvisor*, *Update SKUs to ChannelAdvisor* and *Import SKUs to ChannelAdvisor*.




Figure 1: New WiseRobot Menu

The second change: New configuration named "WiseRobot-ChannelAdvisor"

The second main modification in your Magento admin is in the Configuration Menu. When finishing installing the module, in the Configuration menu you will have a section named "WiseRobot – ChannelAdvisor" which has been already set for your convenience. However, you can adjust and modify this configuration with your own Technical team or with our help. We will discuss how to adjust these settings in the next part of this guide named "WiseRobot-ChannelAdvisor Configuration".

B. WiseRobot-Channel Advisor Configuration

To make changes to the WiseRobot-ChannelAdvisor configuration, do the following:

In the admin menu, select **System** \rightarrow **Configuration**.

In the Configuration section, select WiseRobot-Channel Advisor settings

On your **WiseRobot-ChannelAdvisor Settings** page, there are seven module settings: "ChannelAdvisor API Settings", "Import Orders from ChannelAdvisor", "Update Shipment to ChannelAdvisor", "Update Products to ChannelAdvisor", "Setting for Configurable Product", "Update Products from ChannelAdvisor" and "Ignore Products".




Figure 2: WiseRobot ChannelAdvisor Settings



Part 1: ChannelAdvisor API settings

Configuring the ChannelAdvisor API Settings is the first and foremost critical step in connecting your Magento store to ChannelAdvisor. The API settings process has two-important processes involved.

Step 1: The Initial Stage: Request and authorize a Developer Key

This stage allows you to develop the integration code with the ChannelAdvisor API and to access one or more ChannelAdvisor Client Accounts.

> To request a Developer Key

1. Using your browser, navigate to *ChannelAdvisor API Developer Credentials*. The URL is: http://complete.channeladvisor.com/DeveloperNetwork/RequestApiDevKey.aspx




Figure 3: Request Channel Adsisor API Developer Credentials

- 2. Enter Name, Company, Email Address, Phone Number, Password & Confirm Password
- 3. Read ChannelAdvisor API terms and conditions. If you agree, click Submit Request

Two notification emails from ChannelAdvisor Developer Network will be sent to your registered email after your finishing this step.

The first coming email requires you to activate your developer API credentials. After activating it, you will receive the second email containing your developer key.

> To have your Developer Key authorized

- 1. Using your browser, navigate to the *ChannelAdvisor Client Logan Panel*. The URL is something like: http://complete.channeladvisor.com
- 2. Enter your User name and Password·
- 3. In the admin menu, select My Account \rightarrow Developer Network \rightarrow Account Authorizations.
- 4. From the **Account Authorizations** page, get **Profile ID**
- > After getting profile ID, do the following:




Figure 4: Account Authorization

1. Send us your **developer key**, and its **password** to <u>support@wiserobot.com</u> which you used to request developer key and **Profile ID**, we will then generate a request to access your ChannelAdvisor API.

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- 2. Login to your ChannelAdvisor account again, a notification from the request will appear below the Account List on your account authorizations page.
- 3. From this page, Click **Approve Access** from Actions column.




Figure 5: Account Authorizations – Account List

Step 2: Connecting from Magento to ChannelAdvisor using ChannelAdvisor Account ID

- > Access the WiseRobot ChannelAdvisor Settings
- 1. Login to your Magento admin panel using your own browser.
- 2. In the admin menu, select System \rightarrow Configuration.
- 3. In the Configuration menu, under WiseRobot-Netsuite, select WiseRobot-Channel Advisor settings → ChannelAdvisor API Settings.

> Connecting from Magento to ChannelAdvisor employing ChannelAdvisor Account ID




Figure 6: ChannelAdvisor API settings

- 1. From the ChannelAdvisor API Settings page, enter your developer key and password.
- 2. In the **Test Mode** tab, do one of the following:
 - ➤ Set **Yes** if only updating some selected products with SKUs which are listed in TestSKUs tab (This tab only appears when you choose **Yes** on the **Test Mode** tab).
 - > Set **No** if updating all products.
- 3. In the **Account ID Source** section, do one of the following:
 - ➤ Set Magento Config and fill Account ID which is taken from the Section Account List on the Account ID column and then click Save Config. Completing this step means that all your mappings will be implemented via this account.




Figure 7: Magento config set

- ➤ Set **Product Attributes** and then a new field "Get Account Id from this Attribute" will added between Account ID source and Account ID. In this new field, select "Color" for example.
- The next step is getting account ID for the Color attribute.




Figure 8: Product attribute set

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> To get the account ID (example for the Color Attribute as selected)




Figure 9: Account ID mapping

- 1. On the Magento Admin Menu, select WiseRobot → ChannelAdvisor API → Account ID Map.
- 2. On the Top-right corner, click the "Add new" button.





Figure 10: Account ID mapping – Add new

- 3. In the **Item Information** section, complete the following required properties:
 - ➤ Attribute value: Modification of this value depends on which attribute you set in "Get Account Id from this attribute". For example, you set this field as Color, then the attribute value is something like Black, White, Blue, Red etc.
 - ➤ ChannelAdvisor Account ID: fill in the Account ID which is taken from the Account List section




➤ **Description** *Optional*): In case you have many Account Ids, this field aids you to specify them.

Click the "Save" button on the top-right corner and finishing mapping your Account ID procedure. (using the example of Color Attributes above, any products with Black Color in English store view will be updated to ChannelAdvisor via the registered account ID which is also your Test account).

Test mode and Test SKUs are designed to export or import only designated SKUs listed in Test SKUs from Magento to ChannelAdvisor (each SKU is distinguished from others by a comma).

All products involved in the chosen attribute will be updated when any changes happen.




Figure 11: Import orders from ChannelAdvisor

- 1. To activate this function, set **Active** to "Enable".
- 2. Set **Only import Cleared payment order** to one of the following:
 - > Yes: Orders are imported or invoiced only after payments are received.
 - > No: All orders are imported before payments are received.
- 3. Set Using Shipping Address as Billing Address when Billing Address is blank to one of the following:
 - ➤ Yes: Shipping Address is employed as Billing Address when lacking Billing Address.
 - ➤ No: Simply leave the Billing Address blank.

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- 4. To add prefix to order ID: Set **Order ID prefix mode** to one of the following:
 - ➤ No prefix: Use Magento default order number schema only.
 - > Prefix using Setting only: Fill in the Order Id Prefix section the prefix you want to add to order ID.
 - > Prefix using Marketplace only:
 - ➤ In Magento Admin Menu, select WiseRobot → Channel Advisor API → Manage Sales Source for Order Import.
 - ➤ In this page, choose the **sales source** or the marketplace that you want to add prefix such as AMAZON IT, AMAZON WEBSTORE UK etc.
 - Click to expand the **sales source** and complete the following fields:
 - > Set **Status** to "*Enable*" to activate this application.
 - > In the Sales Source field, keep as it is or change to other sales sources.
 - > Set **Enable Email** to "*Enable*" if you want to receive the notification from the system that you've finished adding prefix to your order ID at chosen marketplace.
 - > Enter **Order Prefix** section the prefix you like such as AMUK standing for AMAZON UK etc.

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


Figure 12: Manage Sales Source for Order Import




Figure 13:Order ID Prefix for Sales Source

- ➤ When complete, click the "Save" button.
- > Prefix using setting and marketplace: doing both section b and c above.
- 5. Set Import ChannelAdvisor Tax to Magento Tax to one of the following:
 - > Yes: Taxes are displayed on the Magento imported sales order.
 - > No: Taxes are hidden on the Magento imported sales order.

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- 6. Set **Frequency** as needed: from every 5 minutes to every 6 hours. Frequency can be defined as a time frame set to manage how often import order processing occurs.
- 7. Set **Reduce stock when order imported** to "*Yes*" to decrease the amount of stocks in Magento equal to the amount of stocks which are ordered by customers like order placed on Magento site.
- 8. Set **Use Two-letter abbreviated codes for the states** to "*Yes*" to activate this function. For example, NA standing for North American, NC for North Carolina etc.
- 9. Set Using Shipping Address as Billing Address when Billing Address is blank to one of the following:
 - ➤ Yes: Shipping Address is employed as Billing Address when lacking Billing Address.
 - ➤ No: Simply let Billing Address blank.
- 10. **Default Shipping**/ **Payment Method**: there are some shipping/ payment methods for you to set as a default. To add, delete or create new shipping/ payment method for order imported to Magento from ChannelAdvisor, you can find more information at Section C WiseRobot Tab Settings Part 5: *Shipping Method Mapping and Payment Method Mapping Settings*.
- 11. **Skip update order when order has status:** when your order is currently in one of these statuses, it won't be updated even if there are any changes in the orders.
- 12. When complete, click "Save" the button.

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Part 3: Update Shipment to ChannelAdvisor

The ChannelAdvisor connector allows you to update shipment details from Magento to ChannelAdvisor. When shipment is generated for an imported order, the tracking information and items shipped will be updated to ChannelAdvisor.




Figure 14: Update Shipment to ChannelAdvisor

- 1. Set **Active** to "Enable" to update shipment information to ChannelAdvisor.
- 2. Set **Use carrier mapping** to "*Yes*" and click the "Save Config" button and then do the following:
 - ➤ In Magento Admin menu, select WiseRobot → Channel Advisor API → Shipping Carrier Map (this new menu item only appears when setting Use Carrier Mapping to Yes).
 - ➤ On the **Shipping Carriers Mapping** section, click the "Add New" button and complete the required fields:
 - > Select **Magento Shipping Carrier** such as Federal Express, DHL etc.
 - > Select **ChannelAdvisor Shipping Method** such as UPS Ground, US Postal Service Priority Mail etc.

Completing these fields means that you have just created a new mapping carrier which links the shipping carrier **DHL** in Magento to the shipping method **UPS – Ground** in ChannelAdvisor.

➤ When complete, click the "Save" button.




Figure 15: Shipping carriers mapping




Figure 16: Shipping carriers mapping – add new

- 3. In **Update Shipment Tracking when an order has status** section: Select current order statuses to update shipment tracking. For example, if you choose current orders containing statuses like "Complete" or "Canceled", shipment details of these two orders will be updated to ChannelAdvisor accordingly.
- 4. When finish, click the "Save Config" button.

Part 4: Update Products to Channel Advisor

This function allows you to update changes in products from Magento to ChanelAdvisor such as quantity of products, product descriptions, images etc.




Figure 17: Update products to ChannelAdvisor

- 1. Set **Active** to "Enable" to start updating product inventory from Magento to Channel Advisor.
- 2. Set **Update function** to one of the following:
 - ➤ **Default** Updating products can run immediately by Magento "*Default*" code.
 - ➤ Exec Function: Updating of products can run using the php exec() function which requires support from your server or hosting provider to enable the exec() function if it's currently disabled.
 - > Cron job: Updating products can run at a user defined designated interval.

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
- 3. Set **Update mode** to one of the following:
 - ➤ **Product Info Only**: Accurate, Consistent and Update-to-date information about product attributes is updated.
 - **Quantity Only**: Only the Quantity of products is updated.
 - ➤ **Product Info and Quantity**: Both product information and quantity are updated to ChannelAdvisor.
- 4. Set **Quantity Update Type** to one of the following:
 - ➤ **Absolute:** Available inventory = the quantity value uploaded.
 - ➤ **Relative**: Available inventory = current inventory + uploaded inventory quantity.
 - ➤ Available: Available inventory = The quantity value uploaded Open (Open Auctions for this SKU).
 - ➤ **InStock**: Available inventory = Uploaded Inventory Quantity Open Pending Checkout Pending Payment Cleared.
 - ➤ Unshipped: Available Inventory = Uploaded Inventory Quantity Open Pending Checkout Pending Payment Cleared Pending Shipment (paid or unpaid).
- 5. Set **Allow create new products** to \$Yes% to generate new products to ChannelAdvisor in case data of these products are not available in ChannelAdvisor.
- 6. In the **Update image** field, you can decide the image which you would like to update by choosing image file name or *image URL*. Otherwise, select "*Disable*" if you do not want to update any changes.
- 7. Set **Categories format** to one of the following:
 - ➤ Plain Text: Categories are formatted in Plain text.
 - > Array as Json: Categories are formatted in Array as Json.

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- 8. Set **Allow use image of parent product** to "Yes" to utilize image of parent products for child products.
- 9. Set **Use Parent Description For Missing Child Description** to *\$Yes*" to employ description of parent product for its missing child product.
- 10. Set **Price for configurable's associated products** to one of the following:
 - > Normal Price: A product itself is priced at its normally setting price
 - ➤ Calculate from super product configuration: A product is priced according to its parent product price.
- 11. In the **Delete product on Magento will also delete on ChannelAdvisor** section, select one of the following:
 - ➤ Yes: Allow you to delete product on Magento and ChannelAdvisor simultaneously.
 - ➤ No: Deleting product on Magento doesn't affect on the amount of product on ChannelAdvisor.
- 12. Set **Delete disable product** to "Yes" to eliminate disabled products.
- 13. In the **Stock for drop-ship item** field, enter the default stock quantity for drop ship items for your current product status.
- 14. Set **Out of stock product send stock level 0** to "*Yes*" means the stock level equals 0 when your products are out of stock and are therefore disabled on ChannelAdvisor.
- 15. Set **Disable product stock level 0** to "Yes" to avoid any inconvenience for clients if your products run out of stock.
- 16. In the **Distribution center code** field: enter the distribution code.
- 17. In the **Default condition status** section: choose default condition status such as "New"; "Used", "Reconditioned", "Refurbished" for all of your products in your web-store.

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18. Set **Skip update if attribute has no value** to "*Yes"* if an attribute has no value (blank field on product's attribute) to then have our module skip its update.



Part 5: Setting for Configurable/ Grouped Products

Configurable and Grouped Products can be loaded from Magento to ChannelAdvisor by following these steps:

Step 1: Getting the relationship name from corresponding variations on ChannelAdvisor

- 1. Using your browser, navigate to the *ChannelAdvisor Client Logging Panel*. The URL is something like: http://complete.channeladvisor.com
- 2. Enter your User name and Password
- 3. In the admin menu, select **Inventory** \rightarrow **Products.** Click to expand **Products Variations**




Figure 18: Product variations page

Step 2: Change settings to allow update configurable/ grouped products into variations on ChannelAdvisor.

Go back to the Settings for Configurable/Grouped Products page and do the following:

1. Set Allow Update Configurable/Grouped Products to "Yes".

Then the new field "Send Configurable/Grouped Products As" will appear. Set this field to Send configurable/grouped as parent item with relationship.

- 2. Set Use Default Relationship Name to "Yes".
- 3. In the **Default Relationship Name** section, enter the relationship name you take from step 01 such as *Color*.

4. When complete, click the "Save Config" button.




Figure 19: Settings for configurable/grouped products

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Part 6: Update Products from ChannelAdvisor

In accordance with the *Features* of the **ChannelAdvisor to Magento Connector**, our module can help you transfer product and order information reciprocally. Hence, if changes in products in ChannelAdvisor are found, our module will update these changes from ChannelAdvisor to Magento, so product information in both ChannelAdvisor and Magento will be updated if this is also enabled as well as updating Magento to Channel advisor, as well as this if desired one way communication from ChannelAdvisor to Magento can be enabled here.




Figure 20: Update products from ChannelAdvisor

- 1. Set **Active** to "Enable" to activate updating products from ChannelAdvisor.
- 2. In the field **Only Update Item With Label**, enter Item Label. Only Items with these given labels will be updated to Magento.
- 3. Set **Update option** to one of the following as needed, namely "Update Product Info and Quantity", "Update Quantity Only", "Update Product Info Only".

- 4. Set Allow Import Images to "Yes" to Import Item's Images from ChannelAdvisor to Magento.
- 5. Set **Skip Update if Attribute has no value** to "Yes" if an attribute has no value then skip its update.
- 6. In the **Category Import Mode** section, there are two methods to import your categories. Please find more information at *Section C : WiseRobot Tab Settings Part 3: Category import methods*.
- 7. Set **Set in stock if stock level greater than 0** to "*Yes*". If a product whose quantity is greater than 0, its product availability status will be in stock.
- 8. Set **Disable Product if stock level is 0** to "Yes". If a product whose quantity is 0, its product status will be Disable.
- 9. Set **Allow create new products** to "Yes" to generate new products on Magento in case data of these products are not available on Magento.
- 10. Set **Product type for parent product** to "*Configurable*" if you want to import parent product as configurable product. Otherwise, set it to "*Grouped*".
- 11. In the field **Default Attribute Set:** Choose an attribute that you want to make it as a default when updating new product.
- 12. Set **Default status** to "*Enable*" and then new product status will show up on the front-end page.
- 13. In the **Default Visibility for Parent or Child Products** section, do one of the following:
 - ➤ Catalog: Your new products will be displayed on a catalog list
 - > Search: Lour new products will be showed on search mode
 - ➤ Catalog and Search: Your new products will be exposed on both a catalog list and search mode.

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- ➤ No Visible Individually: Your new products will be hidden on the catalog list and search mode.
- 14. Set **Show image of child products** to "*Yes*" to allow images of child products to show on parent product view.
- 15. In Page size section: select the amount of products that you want to test at a time.
- 16. In the **Frequency** section: select a designated time frame as needed.
- 17. When finish, click "Save Config" the button.



Part 7: Ignore Products

Activating this function will allow you to ignore updating some products from Magento to ChannelAdvisor and vice versa.




Figure 21: Ignore products

- 1. Set **Allow ignore products** to "Yes" to enable "Ignore Products".
- 2. In the **SKUs for ignore** section: Enter the SKUS in this field. These listed SKUs will be skipped throughout updating-product process. Please input a comma to separate each single SKU.
- 3. In the **Ignore if SKU has character** field: any SKUs containing listed characters will be ignored throughout updating-product process.

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C. Wiserobot tab Settings

Part 1: Attribute Mapping Settings

Our connector module has a mapping tool to aid you map the attributes from Magento to ChannelAdvisor accurately and easily.

> To set attribute map from Magento to ChannelAdvisor




Figure 22: Magento Attribute to Channel Advisor Attribute mapping tool

In the Magento Admin Menu, navigate to **WiseRobot** → **ChannelAdvisor API** → **Attribute**Map. Click to expand this tab and complete these following fields:

1. In the **Magento Attribute and ChannelAdvisor Attribute** section: select the product attributes. Those attributes are available in both Magento and ChannelAdvisor. By selecting one attribute in Magento Attribute in this list and map it to one respective attribute in ChannelAdvisor, you can generate a Mapping Table to update and synchronize data between

Magento and ChannelAdvisor. (For example: Mapping an attribute "Name" in Magento to an attribute "Title" in ChannelAdvisor).

- 2. In the field **Apply to**, pick one of four product types: All Product Types, Parent Product, Child Product, and Simple Product. And the synchronization between Magento and ChannelAdvisor will be applied to the type of product you choose.
- 3. Set Use Data from Parent Product to one of the following:
 - ➤ Yes: Allow to update data such as Name, Price, Description, Image etc. from Parent Product (in case the product type is Child Product).
 - ➤ No: Child Product will get data from itself, not from Parent Product.
- 4. Set **Use in** to one of the following:
 - **Export only**: Update product's attributes from Magento to ChannelAdvisor.
 - > Import only: Update product's attributes from ChannelAdvisor to Magento.
 - **Both**: product's attributes will be updated both ways.
 - None: Product's attributes will not be updated either from Magento or ChannelAdvisor.
- 5. Select the check box in **Use Value** section: one new text box named "*Value*" will appear and the column "*Use Data from Parent Product*" will disappear.

It means that instead of getting data from product's attributes, you can make it for your own by inputting data. Since there are some differences between Magento and ChannelAdvisor, this function may be useful.

6. To finish Mapping your Attributes, click the "Add to mapping table" button and please do not forget to click the "Save Mapping Table" button to save your changes.

You should know product characteristics' name in Magento Code, Magento Attribute Name and ChannelAdvisor Attribute respectively in order to map them accurately. If you would like help mapping your attributes please contact us at support@wiserobot.com.

Part 2: Attribute Set Mapping Settings

In ChannelAdvisor, you can only get "relationship name", "parent" or "is_parent", etc. but you won't know which attributes are in parent-child relationship. Therefore, this section will help you clarify these relationships when creating a configurable product.

Thanks to the product relationship, if it is a parent item, it will be converted to a corresponding configurable product when importing products to Magento.

Step 1:To Create Variations on ChannelAdvisor

- 1. Using your browser, login to *ChannelAdvisor Admin panel*.
- 2. In the admin Menu, navigate to menu **Inventory** → **Product Variations.**




Figure 25: Product Variations

3. On the top-left corner, click to expand **Create New Product Variations** and complete required fields:




Figure 26 Create Variation Relationship

- ➤ Name, Enter the relationship name such as Color and Size etc.
- ➤ Varying Attribute Names, Enter product attributes which belong to this relationship such as Size, Color etc.
- 4. When finish, click the "Save and Continue" button.

Step 2: To map the variation attributes to the specific classification attributes:

Each variation attribute name you defined in step 1 (indicated in red below) needs a real product attribute to have its value. Hence, you need to select an attribute for each of them (selected attributes are indicated in purple below).

You can select the attributes you want to map from **Available Attributes** list, use the **Filter** to get the attribute quickly, then click to **Add** button to select it.

Then click the **Save and Exit** button to finish.




Figure 27: Mapping the variation attributes to the specific classification attributes

Step 3: To map the attribute set in Magento to a ChannelAdvisor variation:

- 1. In the Magento Admin Menu, select WiseRobot \rightarrow ChannelAdvisor API \rightarrow Attribute Set Map.
- 2. Click to expand the "Add New" button and complete the following fields:
 - ➤ ChannelAdvisor Relationship: Enter the Relationship you created on ChannelAdvisor e.g, Color and Size etc.
 - > Set Magento Attribute Set to Default.
 - > Attributes: choose the attributes associated to the relationship.
- 3. When complete, click the "Save" button.




Figure 28: Attribute Set Mapping




Figure 29: Channel Advisor's variations




Figure 30: Attribute Set Map – add new





When a configurable product is sent to ChannelAdvisor, the module will get **attribute set** and **configurable attributes** from that product and check with the mappings to find if a **ChannelAdvisor Relationship** is defined.

Eg: If that product attribute set is **Default** and use configurable attribute **FS Color** and **FS Size**, from the mapping in the screen shot above, we have relationship **Color and Size**.

Then the configurable product and its associated products will have that relationship set correctly on ChannelAdvisor.

Part 3: Category Import Methods Settings

Before importing category methods in ChannelAdvisor to Magento, you need to set up categories in Magento first.

> To set up Categories in Magento

1. In the Magento Admin Menu, navigate to Catalog → Manage Categories.




Figure 31: Root category set

- 2. In the **New Root Category** page, complete the required fields: Name, Is Active, Thumbnail Image, Description, Image etc.
- 3. When finished, click the "Save Category" button.

- **There are **three methods** to import categories from ChannelAdvisor to Magento:
- **▶** Method 1: Use Category IDs in Attribute Map
 - Step 1: Create an attribute in ChannelAdvisor
 - 1. Using your browser, navigate to the *ChannelAdvisor Admin Page*.
 - 2. In the Admin Menu, select **Inventory** \rightarrow **Grouping** \rightarrow **Attributes.**




Figure 32: Create New Attributes

3. In the Attribute Page, select **Create New Attribute** button and complete the following fields

- > Attribute Name: Fill the name of an attribute that will appear on your inventory.
- ➤ In **Attribute Type** section: Select *Appears on all items in Inventory* or *Only used on items in a set of classifications*.
- 4. When complete, click the "Save" button.




Figure 33: Create New Attributes-Successfully

<u>Step 2:</u> Map Magento Attribute to ChannelAdvisor Attribute.

- 1. In Magento Admin Menu, navigate to **WiseRobot** → **ChannelAdvisor API** A **Attribute Map** and do the following:
 - ➤ Magento Attribute: Always select *Category Ids* to show which attribute on ChannelAdvisor referencing to the ID's of Magento Categories that a product belongs to
 - ➤ ChannelAdvisor Attribute: Select any attributes which contain category Ids.

Set Use Data from Parent Product to "No".

> Set **Use in** to *Import Only*.

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- ➤ Don't choose Use Value.
- 2. When complete, click the "Save Mapping Table" button.




Figure 34: Attribute mapping tool

Then when products are imported, they will have the category set correctly from that attribute item in ChannelAdvisor.



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➤ Method 2: Use Classification/Category Map

1. In Magento Admin Menu, navigate to WiseRobot \rightarrow ChannelAdvisor API \rightarrow Classification/Category Map.




Figure 36: Classification/ Category map

- 2. Click to expand **Add New** button and complete two required fields:
 - **Category**: select one of Magento categories.
 - **Classification**: select one of the available classifications.
- 3. When complete, click "Save" the button to add them to the mapping table.

(As can be seen in the screen shot, once the mapping is saved, the item will have the classification **Bath Sheets** and then will be imported into Magento with category **Towels & Bedding** under the **Default Category**).

➤ Method 3: Use attribute mapping method

- In Magento Admin Menu, navigate to WiseRobot → ChannelAdvisor API → Attribute
 Map and do the following:
 - ➤ Magento Attribute: Always select *Category Name* to show which attribute on ChannelAdvisor referencing to the name of Magento Categories that a product belongs to.
 - ➤ ChannelAdvisor Attribute: Select any attributes which contain category name.
 - > Set Use Data from Parent Product to "No".
 - > Set **Use in** to *Import Only*.
 - > Do not choose Use Value.
- 2. When complete, click "Save Mapping Table" the button

Part 4: Image Placement Setttings

Due to differing management structures, Image management in Magento is somewhat different from the one in ChannelAdvisor. Thus, we need to create an "**Image placement**" for images in Magento to make it easier to be mapped to the corresponding one in ChannelAdvisor when updated. In other words, when you change images in Magento, it will be sent to ChannelAdvisor directly at the correct image placement.

> To manage image placements for product update

1. In Magento Admin Menu, navigate to WiseRobot → ChannelAdvisor API → Image Placements




Figure 39: Image placement set


- 2. On the top-right corner, click to expand the "Add New" button and complete the required fields:
 - ➤ Name: do the following to enter exactly the name of ChannelAdvisor Image Placements

 (On ChannelAdvisor Admin Panel, select Inventory → Images → Image Hosting. A list of ChannelAdvisor Image Placements is available for you to choose).
 - ➤ Order: Enter sequentially. For example, the image name is ITEMINAGEURL4, in the Order field, enter 4.

3. When complete, click the "Save" button.

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Part 5: Shipping Methods and Payment Methods Mapping Settings

> Shipping Methods Map

One of the fundamental features of the ChannelAdvisor to Magento Connector is *Order Management and Fulfillment*. To manage and fulfill orders from ChannelAdvisor, information about fulfillment such as shipping carrier, shipping class etc. needs map to Magento. Our Shipping Methods Mapping tool accelerates the mapping process easier.

> To change, create or add new shipping methods map

1. In the Magento Admin Menu, select WiseRobot → ChannelAdvisor API → Shipping Methods Map.




Figure 41: Shipping methods mapping

- 2. On the top-right corner, Click to expand the "Add New" button and complete the following
 - > Select Magento Shipping Method such as Free Shipping, Federal Express-Ground etc.
 - ➤ Select ChannelAdvisor Shipping Method such as UPS-Ground, Amazon Merchant@ Standard etc.

3. When complete, click "Save" the button.

 - > To change, create or add new payment methods map
 - 1. In the Magento Admin Menu, select WiseRobot → ChannelAdvisor API → Payment Methods Map.




Figure 43: Payment Methods Mapping

 - > Select Magento Payment Method such as Credit Card, Cash on Delivery, Sears etc.
 - > Enter ChannelAdvisor Payment Method.

Part 6: Manage Sales Sources for Product Update Settings

Orders at many marketplaces will flow into Magento from ChannelAdvisor at a user designated interval (10 minutes by default). When orders are sent to Magento, they can be managed and fulfilled.

With our connector, you can decide which sales sources are connected to ChannelAdvisor to import orders from. Furthermore, sending emails obtaining inclusive of order information to clients is also under your control.

> To manage Sales Sources for Products Update:

- 1. In the Magento Admin Menu, select **WiseRobot** → **ChannelAdvisor API**.
- 2. Click Manage Sales Source for Order Import and do one of the following:




Figure 45: Manage sales source for order import

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- ➤ Select the check box of a specific sales source to import order and change status to *Enable*. Then click **Save** button.
- > On the top-right corner, click to expand "Add New" button and complete the following:
 - > Set **Status** to *Enable* to activate this tool.
 - In the **Sales Source** field, select sales sources you want to import orders.
 - ➤ Set **Enable Email** to *Enable* if you want to receive the notification from the system that you've finished adding prefix to your order ID at chosen marketplace.
 - Enter **Order Prefix** section the prefixes which are convenient for your management such as AMUK standing for AMAZON_UK etc.
 - In the **Order prefix** section, you create the prefix for each Sales Source, our module can base on it (Order prefix) to identify orders and send fulfillment information such as shipping carrier, shipping fee, type and other shipping details to clients via ChannelAdvisor.
- 3. When finishing your set up at new item information in Manage Sales Source of Products Update, please do not forget to click the "Save" button.

Part 7: Mass Update to Channel Advisor Settings

"Mass Update to Channel Advisor" in Channel Advisor API is one of the most indispensable tools that our module aids you in updating a huge amount of information into Channel Advisor from modifications or changes in Magento. This script is most often used right at the start of integrating your Magento store with Channe Advisor when you need to update all product inventory in one go, or when you need to update some SKU's due to recent mass updates via CSV files.

> To start Mass Update to ChannelAdvisor:

- 1. In the Magento Admin Menu, navigate to WiseRobot → ChannelAdvisor API.
- 2. Click to expand Mass update to ChannelAdvisor and do the following:
 - In the box "Skip update Attribute(s)", choose attribute(s) that you don't want to update
 - > Click the "Run Mass Update in a new tab" button to commence your Mass update.
- 3. After clicking this button, another taps will appear to let you know whether the Mass Update to ChannelAdvisor is successful or not.




Figure 47: Mass update to ChannelAdvisor

Part 8: Update SKUs to ChannelAdvisor/ Import SKUs or Product Images from ChannelAdvisor

- > To Manually Update SKUs to ChannelAdvisor

- 3. After clicking this button, the new tap will appear to let you know whether the process of




Figure 48: Update SKUs to ChannelAdvisor




Figure 49: Import Products from ChannelAdvisor




Figure 50: Import Product Images from ChannelAdvisor

III. APPENDIX A – Module Scripts

A-1. Cron job Setting

Because the module using Magento cron job system to check products on ChannelAdvisor so the Magento installation must have cron job installed and configured.

You need to set up a cron job to run the file "cron.php" in your Magento directory every 5 minutes.

It looks like:

*/5 * * * * php /path/to/your/magento/cron.php

You can do it by using control panel or run crontab -e on your ssh prompt.

A-2. Export Images to ChannelAdvisor

Command line via SSH:

Change directory to directory "channeladvisorapi" under your Magento directory and execute the "exportImages.php" via php

cd /path/to/your/magento

cd channeladvisorapi

php exportImages.php

A-3. Mass Export to ChannelAdvisor

Command line via SSH:

Change directory to directory "channeladvisorapi" under your Magento directory and execute the "massExport.php" via php

cd/path/to/your/magento

cd channeladvisorapi

php massExport.php



Command line via SSH:

Change directory to directory "test-channeladvisor" under your magento directory and execute "importProducts.php" via php

cd /path/to/your/magento

cd test-channeladvisor

php importProducts.php

A-5. Update product quantity from Magento to ChannelAdvisor

On SSH shell access, change to Magento web directory:

cd /path/to/magento

Change to Channel Advisor scripts directory:

cd channeladvisorapi

Execute update script using php, it's recommended run the update in bulk to avoid PHP memory limit:

php exportQty.php 1 3000

The script will output the result on screen, after that it finished and you then can continue with the rest:

php exportProductURL.php 3000 6000

A-6. Update product URLs from Magento to ChannelAdvisor

On SSH shell access, change to Magento web directory:

cd /path/to/magento

Change to Channel Advisor scripts directory:

cd channeladvisorapi

Execute update script using php, it's recommended run the update in bulk to avoid PHP memory limit:

php exportProductURL.php 1 3000

The script will output the result on screen, after that it finished and you then can continue with the rest:

php exportProductURL.php 3000 6000
